

Dear Parents,

Due to the high number of applicants we are receiving and our limited number of spots available in each classroom, we will be making some changes to our registration and admission process in the future to become more aligned with how other private schools in our area conduct their admission processes. We are still working out the details of what that looks like for our incoming applicants at each grade level. As you know, Poise N Ivy is a preparatory school, not a daycare. Our curriculum and teaching methods are very rigorous, and we need to ensure that each student is capable of keeping up with the class. We want to set our students up for success by giving them the best environment in which to learn. Please note that registration is not a guarantee of admission. You will be contacted by Mrs. Pam with a decision of acceptance upon which she will let you know who your child's teacher will be. We cannot guarantee specific teacher requests. Our PreK 3 teachers assist in placing each student with the PreK 4 teacher whom they feel will be the best fit for your child. All three Pre-K 4 teachers use the same curriculum in their classrooms, customized to their teaching styles and are well equipped to meet your child's educational needs. We work as a team!

Requirements for Pre-K 4 Admission

*Students will not be accepted if they have been expelled or required to withdraw from another school, public or private, for any reason.

*Students will not be accepted if they have educational, behavioral, or psychological disorders that cannot be met in the regular mainstreamed classroom. Poise N Ivy is not equipped to meet these types of special needs.

*Students must be potty trained and able to handle all of their bathroom needs with independence both during class and during aftercare/nap time.

*Students need to be able to follow both single and multiple step directions and handle transitions in the classroom.

*Students need to be able to speak well and be understood by the teacher.

*Parents must be willing to go over homework each night with their child and actively participate in their child's learning experience.

*Parents must be willing to commit to sending their child to school regularly. It is very important for our students to miss as few school days as possible, not including sick days, so that his/her learning experience is not compromised.

*Proper classroom behavior is very important in our school. They will need to be able to interact well with other students and listen to their teacher. They need to be able to sit for short periods of time. They need to be able to hold a pencil properly. We are preparing our students for Kindergarten where they will need to know how to control their actions and speaking in a much larger classroom setting. Parents must be willing to assist us in teaching their child how to accomplish this. Reinforcing these skills at home is very helpful.

The goal of PNI Pre-Kindergarten is to create an environment conducive for learning about God, themselves, and their surroundings, while acquiring vital foundational skills and knowledge for a continual life of learning, exploration, and discovery. Our mission at PNI is to lay a solid foundation for our students on which the rest of life is built. Time is a priceless commodity, and it is our desire to assist parents in utilizing this school year to its fullest potential.
